- Increase policy impact and visibility
 - by jointly formulating recommendations for EU and national policy frameworks (e.g., CAP, Cohesion Policy).

Potential Future Actions:

- Launch of **joint pilot initiatives** or comparative case studies across rural regions.
- Creation of shared communication and dissemination tools.
- Development of joint policy briefs or position papers for EU institutions.
- Signing of a **Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)** to support long-term collaboration.
- Planning a **joint final conference** or follow-up clustering events.
- Design of a common monitoring and evaluation framework.
- Formation of a **cross-project thematic working group** (e.g., on social innovation or inclusive services).

We warmly encourage you to attend and contribute to this dynamic and solution-oriented session. Your experience and ideas can help shape the future of rural policy and practice in Europe.
